Held every week on Tuesday at 7:00 pm

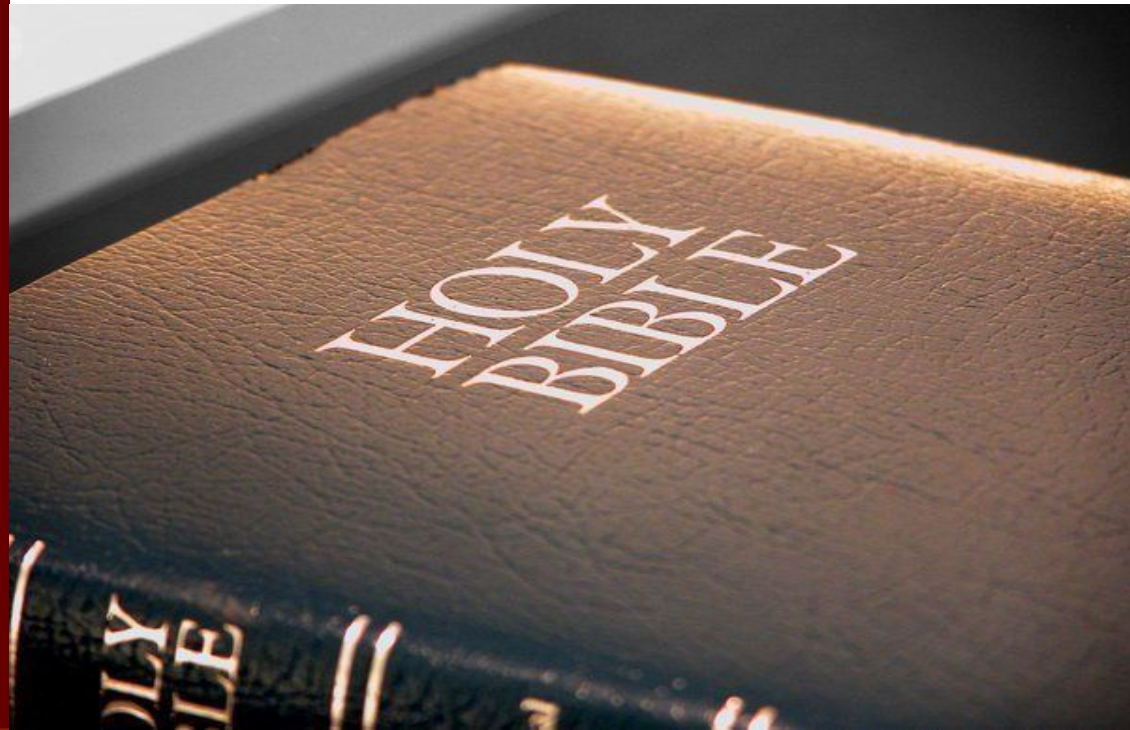
